CORE CLASSES

- Attendance will be taken at the beginning of each class period.
- All core teachers will have students in class during the finals schedule, even if they are not offering a traditional final. Middle school students are expected to attend all core classes (Math, Science, Lang Arts, Social Studies, Bible).

ENCORE

- Encore classes will <u>NOT</u> offer a final.
 - o *7th graders will NOT have a final during 7th period on Thursday and may be picked up at 11:00am.
 - o *8th graders will NOT have a final during 8th period on Friday and may be picked up at 9:30am.
 - o A parent permission slip will be sent home for parents to excuse their child from encore on these days.
 - O Students not picked up will be expected to report to Study Hall during this time.



STUDY HALL/ELECTIVES

- IF your student has <u>STUDY HALL</u> or an <u>ELECTIVE</u> (Band, Choir, PE) to begin the day (1st, 4st, or 5st) OR end the day (3st, 7st, or 8st) ...
 - THEN he/she may arrive late to school or leave early. Study hall <u>WILL</u> be in session and students are allowed to be here to study if not allowed to come late or leave early.
 - o Students with Study Hall in the middle of the day (2nd, and 6th on Wed/Thurs) will report to Study Hall.
 - o Students with an elective in the middle of the day (2nd or 6th on Wed/Thurs) will report to their elective class.
 - BE SURE TO NOTIFY THE OFFICE IF YOUR CHILD WILL NOT BE ATTENDING STUDY HALL THESE DAYS, JUST LIKE ANY OTHER ABSENCE. MS office
- A parent permission slip will be sent home for parents to excuse their child from Band/Choir and/or PE on these days.

LUNCH

- Lunch WILL NOT be served for 7th/8th grade on Wednesday and Thursday. If pre-orders have been made, they have been cancelled for these days.
- 6th grade WILL have lunch served at the normal time on Wednesday and Thursday.
- NO lunch on Friday for all K-12 students due to the 11 AM dismissal.

OTHER

- MS students MAY NOT pick up elementary siblings prior to elementary dismissal time @ 3:15 pm on Wed & Thurs.
- All MS students will be expected to stay in their classrooms for the entire testing period.
- The office will be closing shortly after 8th period on Friday, Dec 21st (11:00 am). Please make arrangements for students to be picked up no later than 11:15 am.
