JUNIOR HIGH & HIGH SCHOOL

- Attendance will be taken at the beginning of each class period. Absences (even if the student was granted a Finals Exception) will count toward the 10 allowed per semester before the student loses credit for the course.
- All classes will fit into one of three categories: 1) no final, 2) final, or 3) project. Students are required to be in class unless it falls in the "no final" category, which only happens in Choir, PE, Band, JH Exploratories, and Study Hall.
 - **IF** your student does not have a final or a project/presentation in the first period of the day (1st, 3rd, or 7th), **THEN** they may arrive late.
 - **IF** your student does not have a final or a project/presentation in the last period of the day (5th, 6th, or 8th), **THEN** they may leave early if they are a student driver or have arranged pick up with a parent.
- IF students are finished for the day, THEN...
 - They <u>may not linger in hallways and/or classrooms and disrupt other finals</u>. The Media Center will be open until 3:10 pm for students awaiting parent pick up.
 - They *may not* pick up Elementary siblings prior to 3:20 pm.

HIGH SCHOOL ONLY

- **IF** your <u>high school</u> student has spent a minimum of 30 minutes in class <u>AND</u> they have completed their final <u>AND</u> they don't have another final for the day, **THEN** they may leave early if they are a student driver or have arranged pick up with a parent.
- IF your <u>high school</u> student is finished for the day, **THEN** they <u>may not</u> pick up Junior High siblings unless the JH student is done with finals for the day and only at the end of the class period. The HS student <u>may not</u> interrupt class to pick up a sibling.
