



Off-Campus Course Offerings

DMCS is pleased to offer a number of off-campus course opportunities to our students in addition to our in-house course offerings. We have three partners in this process, two of whom offer their classes as dual credit for both high school and college credit.

Schedule these courses with Mrs. Kostek so we know how they fit into your four year plan for graduation. Families are responsible for the online registration and payment for the courses. There is no credit transfer fee for these courses as they are extensions of our faith integrated curriculum.

Cedarville Academy

This option is open to juniors and seniors. These courses are a dual credit option as they are college level courses. Students may take two courses per year (one per semester) through Cedarville Academy.

Admission Requirements:

Students need to have a GPA of 3.5 for seniors and 3.7 for juniors Be involved in a college prep high school curriculum Standardized test scores in top 25% Excellent church leader recommendation School staff recommendation

Fees: Courses cost \$150 per credit hour plus textbooks and any course fees that may apply. Textbooks are available through the campus bookstore or Amazon.com.

Northwestern College Early College Program

This dual credit option is open to juniors and seniors in good academic standing at our school. NWC staff utilize a variety of media in teaching the classes such as course guides, video lectures, CD-ROM, textbooks and online learning.

Admission:

Students need to have a GPA of 2.0 to enroll in classes Juniors must rank in the upper \(^{1}\square\) of their class Seniors must rank in the upper ½ of their class

Students must maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0 to remain enrolled in program

Fees: Courses cost \$192 per credit hour with most classes being three credit hour courses. The books and materials are provided on a loan basis or are online so there is no expense for textbooks. A few courses have an added lab fee. Tuition may be paid at one time or on a four month payment plan. There is no registration or application fee.

Alpha-Omega Academy

This academy option is available to students in grades 7-12 as a credit recovery tool. Students who have failed a semester of a class may choose the same or compatible course to complete on a summer school basis through Alpha-Omega Academy. AOAcademy provides daily interaction with teachers via live chat or by telephone between 8:00-4:00pm CST. This is not a dual credit option for students

Admission requirements:

Alpha-Omega Academy is open to assist students from all academic levels in the successful completion of their coursework. Registration is completed online by parents.

Fees:

Registration fee is \$185. Each class costs \$170 per semester or \$340 per year. (It is not calculated by credit hour). There may be a small fee for lab work in some classes.

Course Offerings:
