To reflect the many changes you'll see at this event compared to the past Auction and Benefit Event, we decided a new name was needed. "True-Blue" means unwavering loyalty or faithfulness; we think this new name is a great way to refer to this celebration of God's incredible faithfulness to DMCS and the loyalty and faithfulness of the DMCS community.

### How are the funds raised at the True-Blue Gala used?
