# Course Description Grade 5 Social Studies

**Philosophy Statement:** Social Studies is the systematic study of the social structures of the world from creation to the present day. By studying the individual components of social studies we learn how God's sovereign hand directs the affairs of mankind to reveal and accomplish His purpose. ("Look unto me, and be saved, all the ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is none else." Isaiah 45:22) Each area of study sees God as the Divine Creator of all things; in control of every aspect of history, at work in the lives of individuals, and in control of timing of events on the earth in order to reveal His glory and expand His kingdom.

*Course Objective:* The students will study and explore the geography and history of the Eastern Hemisphere. Students will learn about the first people who lived in Mesopotamia, continuing with the study of the Middle East, then the rest of Asia, Africa, Europe, Australia, and Antarctica. They will learn from a biblical perspective about the things God has accomplished through the people and nations in each of these locations since the creation of the world through current times. This will be accomplished through the use of reading, discussion, map studies, research, and participation in individual and group projects.
