

Course Description

Grade 6 Bible

Philosophy Statement: Through the teaching and study of God's Word, we desire to equip students to know the fullness of God, to pursue His truth, and glorify Him in word and deed. (Ephesians 3:16-17).

Course Objective: The students will survey part of the Old Testament, conduct an in-depth study of selected Old Testament passages, and participate in activities to help them apply the Scriptures to important issues faced by sixth grade students. The students will become acquainted with Biblical history, and see God's faithfulness to his people throughout time.

Time Allotment: 30 minutes per day, 4 days per week and Chapel, once weekly for 40 minutes

Course Content:

- In the Fullness of Time (Christmas): Celebration of Christ
- Within the Royal House: The design for redemption laid before Christ's birth
- Through the Providence: God's provision for strong leaders
- By the Incarnate Word: The prophecies of redemption
- To the Ends of the Earth: Responsibility to spread the good news
- At the Appointed Time: Revelations
- Bible study methods
