

# **Director of Safety & Security Job Description**

## **Purpose of Position**

The Director of Safety & Security fulfills the mission of Des Moines Christian School by leading the strategic development, implementation, and oversight of a comprehensive, forward-thinking safety & security program at a school of approximately 1,300 students, with 250 faculty and staff, on a 28-acre suburban campus. This position operates in a way that supports the unique environment of a Christian school and balances the need for a strong safety and security program with the desire to maintain a thriving school culture.

#### **Qualifications:**

Bachelor's degree in a job-related area.

- Leadership experience within law enforcement, security, or emergency management within a federal, state, or local agency required.
- CPR & First Aid required.
- Firearms training and certifications.
- In agreement with the Des Moines Christian School (DMCS) Statement of Faith.
- Active member/regular attendee of Bible-believing church and committed to growth in their personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

## Responsibilities:

- Oversees all safety and security programs and protocols of the school and develops plans and strategies for continual improvement in these areas.
- Serves as a primary liaison with local law enforcement, fire, and other emergency managers and first responders.
- Annually leads and conducts an internal safety and security assessment.
- Leads the Crisis Management team and any response effort in the event of an emergency or crisis situation.
- Annually reviews and updates all policies, procedures, and emergency operational plans
- Develops an annual calendar of drills, training programs, and assessments.
- Collaborates with the IT Director to ensure the school's security-related technology adequately supports the campus.
- Collaborates with the Property and Facilities Director to ensure the school's facilities are adequately
  maintained to support safety and security.
- Acts as primary administrator of door and security camera systems.
- Leads work related to functionality and placement of campus security cameras.
- Oversees the safety and security for daily activities as well as after-school functions and large-scale community events.
- Develops, recommends, and implements a physical security program for evening campus security.
- Leads or participates in investigations and preventative behavior measures involving students, staff, and faculty as needed.
- Manages the Transportation department, including directing the Transportation Coordinator who
  oversees safety and security protocols, fleet maintenance and scheduling, and drivers.
- Evaluates and assesses the overall risk profile and protocols for the school's activities, including transportation, local field trips, out-of-state trips, and international experiences.
- Leads development and implementation of a 'Door Greeter' program.
- Manages department budget.
- May serve as the media spokesperson for the school on matters related to safety and security.
- All other duties as assigned.

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
